## SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

### 1. Announcement

Eastern Counties Motor Club and West Suffolk Motor Club will organise a Touring Assembly on Sunday 12<sup>th</sup> May 2024.

Start: Corn Craft Tea Room, Monks Eleigh, Hadleigh Rd, Ipswich, IP7 7AY – Bacon rolls and tea/coffee included.

Lunch: Mid Suffolk Light Railway, Wetheringsett, Stowmarket, IP14 5PW  
- Tea rooms and facilities (entry and rides included).

Finish: Tidemill Yacht Harbour, Tide Mill Way, Woodbridge, IP12 1BY.  
With Woodbridge Tidemill, and free entry to Woodbridge Museum, The Longshed – Sutton Hoo longship replica project, 2 Cafes and the scenic waterfront.

### 2. Jurisdiction

This meeting will be held under the General Regulations of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), and these Supplementary Regulations and any additional instructions that may be issued for the event.

Motorsport UK certificate of exemption will be issued, details to follow.

### 3. Eligibility

The event is open to all cars manufactured prior to 31 December 1999 plus any other cars the organisers may consider 'classic' or 'interesting' (*Note: If you are interested in the event your car will be 'interesting'.*)

All cars must comply with the legal requirements to run on the road. Advertising, trade signs or promotional displays may not be carried or displayed. Period advertising in keeping with the vehicle and event will be considered by the organiser. Decisions on the eligibility of entries are at the discretion of the organisers, the organisers decisions are final.

Members of the public may participate; Club membership cards and Motorsport UK licenses are NOT required.

### 4. Identification

Participation vehicles will be identified by a 'rally plate' supplied by the organisers.

## 5. Documentation

At the start of the event entrants will be issued with a detailed road book, rally plate, entrants list and additional information to enable them to complete the event.

## 6. Insurance

Entrants will be required to sign a declaration that they have valid insurance appropriate to the event in accordance with RTA requirements.

## 7. Entries

Entries open on the publishing of these regulations and closes at 23:59 on Monday 6th May 2024.

The maximum entry for the meeting is 65 and the minimum is 40, the organisers reserve the right to cancel the event should the minimum number not be reached. Entries will be acknowledged by email whenever possible. In the event of the event being oversubscribed a reserve list will be operated by the organisers.
